Shevin, Florida's former two-term Attorney General and later member of the Third District Court of Appeal. Among the many significant matters they litigated together was the successful representation of Joseph Robbie and Dolphin Stadium Corporation in various lawsuits concerning the land use and zoning decisions allowing for the construction of Dolphin Stadium.

Mr. Waldman founded the firm in 1991 and now, with the able assistance of his partner, Craig Trigoboff (a 13-year Weston resident), divides his practice between litigation matters and other engagements in which he serves as a state and federal court-appointed Mediator, an Arbitrator (certified by the American Arbitration Association and the American Health Lawyers Association), and a Special Master appointed by the Broward Circuit Court Complex Litigation Unit. For 2009, Mr. Waldman was distinguished by Florida Trend -- The Magazine of Florida Business as one of the "Florida Legal Elite" (top 2% of all lawyers practicing in Florida), and by Law & Politics as one of the Florida Super Lawyers (top 5% of lawyers practicing in Florida). Mr. Trigoboff, who handles many of the firm's real estate clients, graduated from Emory University in 1987 and The University of Miami School of law in 1990.
